- Marine Highway Corridors "[t]he Secretary shall extensions of the surface transportation system..." designate short sea transportation routes as
- Marine Highway Projects "to designate projects that...provide the greatest benefit to the public."

Marine Highway Projects

- For a new or expanded marine highway services
- The Maritime Administration can provide:
- Technical Assistance
- Coordination with other agency funding sources; e.g., CMAQ





National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010

"The Secretary shall...

designated under subsection (d)." program to implement projects or components of a project establish and implement a short sea transportation grant.

Section 3515:

 "America's short sea transportation grants for the development of marine highways"

To amend Section 55601 of the U.S. Code, Title 46:

Same section as the "America's Marine Highway Program"

Marine Highway Projects:

- Be financially viable!
- Have a market for planned services
- Have a business plan
- At least 20 percent cost share from non-Federal sources including state, regional and local government agencies
